- Complete IRS W-9 Form**with current address & physical signature uploaded into ECE Workforce
 Registry. Click here for help uploading documents into the ECE Workforce Registry.

- Proof of 21 eligible* professional growth hours between May 1, 2022 May 31, 2023 (i.e. training certificates, conference registration/certificates, documentation noting total training hours, etc.) To check your PD hours, simply log-on to your ECE Workforce Registry account, navigate to your home page, and select "View Education and Training Report (PDF)" under quick links. *Note: Eligible professional growth hours include any hours completed during your UNPAID time. If your agency is paying your hourly rate during a training, these hours are not eligible.  to meet with your college's academic counselor or professional growth advisor to develop an
 Academic Plan or a <u>Child Development Permit Professional Growth Plan</u>. These plans must outline
 the classes needed to achieve your degree or upgrade your CA Child Development Permit. After you
 have completed this plan, upload into ECE Workforce Registry. <u>Click here for information about how

- Complete IRS W-9 Form**with current address & physical signature uploaded into ECE Workforce Registry. <u>Click here for help uploading documents into the ECE Workforce Registry.</u>

- Copy of Transcripts verifying eligible* units completed between May 1, 2022 May 31, 2023.
 Upload unofficial or official transcripts into ECE Workforce Registry. Click here for help uploading transcripts into the ECE Workforce Registry.

*Note: Eligible units for this stipend include units earned toward AA or BA in Early Childhood Education (or closely related field) OR to qualify for a Child Development Permit.
